**Agenda Item 1- Call Meeting to Order and Introductions**

**Agenda Item 4 – Possible timeline for adoption and implementation of Social Host Ordinance**

**Andrew Ching** reported the April 28, 2011 Issue Review Session which was originally scheduled to hear discussion of the draft ordinance has been moved to the May 5, 2011 Issue Review Session. Based upon this date, the draft ordinance could have final approval at the beginning of June, 2011. Normally, implementation would take place 30 days from final Council approval. We discussed asking for a stepped enforcement with warnings only after the 30 day period in order to provide adequate time for community education. We suggest ticketing start on January 1, 2012.

Discussion around the diversion education option continued. **Bobbie Cassano** will contact Tim Cox to set a meeting to discuss this piece.

**Agenda Item 5-Preparation for the Issue Review Session on April 28<sup>th</sup>**

As announced earlier in this meeting, the IRS date to hear the Social Host draft language has been moved to the May 5<sup>th</sup> IRS meeting. This means any back-up materials must be sent to the City Clerk by April 26<sup>th</sup>. We decided these materials should include a cover memo which **Bobbie Cassano** will write along with the draft amended ordinance, "Article III. Parties, Gatherings or Events".
