RECOMMENDATION: No action is required by the City Council at this public hearing. After the hearing, staff will prepare preliminary program activities for City Council's review at the upcoming Issue Review Session.

ADDITIONAL INFO: The purpose of the first public hearing is to obtain input from citizens regarding how the estimated \$1,592,703 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and \$471,526 in HOME funds might be allocated.

Through this hearing process, staff will prepare various funding alternatives for City Council review and selection of which activities to fund in the coming year. The preliminary selection of these activities will take place at the upcoming City Council Issue Review Session. After the Council's preliminary selection of the 2009-2010 program activities, an Action Plan of the City's proposed use of funds will be prepared. A second public hearing will be held to gain further public comment prior to the adoption of the Action Plan. Once the final Action Plan is adopted, staff will submit the plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for approval of the 2009-2010 funding.

Examples of ongoing city programs include affordable housing activities, lead-based paint testing and abatement, property acquisition and disposition, public services, property clearance and demolition, public facilities and improvements, housing rehabilitation and preservation, historic preservation, neighborhood facilities, economic development activities, relocation assistance and planning and administration.
