**SUBJECT:** Request approval of a resolution approving an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the City of Tempe and Kyrene School District No. 28, which details the agreed upon respective responsibilities of the School Resource Officer grant program.

**COMMENTS:** Kyrene School District No. 28 was awarded grant money to fund one temporary officer (10 months) to work specifically in Kyrene Middle School as a School Resource Officer. This IGA covers a period of one year, commencing July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009. As with previous years, the IGA outlines the duties of the officers, the City and the District as per the grant requirements. These officers provide law-related education that promotes a safe environment and good citizenship. The officers also deal with any law enforcement related activities which occur on campus.

**FISCAL NOTE:** Kyrene School District No. 28 applied for and was awarded \$80,044 in grant dollars to fund one (1) full-time temporary officer for the 10 month school year. The district will reimburse the Tempe Police Department for the School Resource Officer from the grant funds the school has received.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve and sign the IGA.

**ADDITIONAL INFO:** The delay in the Kyrene School District forwarding an IGA to the Police Department is the reason the Council is receiving the IGA for approval so late in the school year. The IGA was not received from the Kyrene School District until the second week in May.

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT OF THE TEMPE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND KYRENE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 28 FOR A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER, AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACT AS AGENT FOR THE CITY OF TEMPE FOR ALL NEGOTIATIONS AND NECESSARY INSTRUMENTS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe, at the recommendation of the Police Department, will approve the intergovernmental agreement between the Kyrene School District and the City of Tempe for a School Resource Officer for one year; and

WHEREAS, this project is for the benefit of all citizens of Tempe; and

WHEREAS, the project is compatible with the laws of the United States of America, Arizona and the City of Tempe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, HEREBY:

1. Grant approval of the intergovernmental agreement between Kyrene School District No. 28 and the City of Tempe for School Resource Officers and
2. Gives authority to the Tempe Chief of Police or his designee, to act as agent of the City of Tempe to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, billing statements, and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such funding.
