ADDITIONAL INFO: The Tempe Police Department supports the Seized Asset Community Action (SACA) Summer Grant Program with Racketeering Influenced and Corrupt Organization (RICO) Act proceeds. The Tempe Community Council was responsible for administering the grant program and making recommendations through volunteer reviewers from the TCC Board of Directors. In addition, all applications were reviewed by the Tempe Police Legal Advisor to ensure they met RICO guidelines, and all recommended applications have been approved for funding through the Maricopa County Attorney's Office (a requirement for all RICO expenditures).
