
1. Meeting was called to order at 5 p.m.
2. There were no members from the public present for comments.

Overview – Ginny gave the committee an updated overview of the upcoming event. The Tardeada Advisory Board was asked to coordinate the party at Apache/Price due to the fact that the original Barrios were located in this area. The date of the party is Saturday, December 27<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. We have no budget, however logistical items such as booths, stage, etc. will be provided. A site has been selected, on the north side of Apache, next to the U-Haul property. The benefit of this site is that it is on the main street, which will draw in people from the Light Rail Station 27 and the Park and Ride, but it also has a gate on the north end that opens up to the Victory Acres neighborhood, which will allow the neighbors to get involved.

3. Committees:
  - a. Entertainment – Normalicia Blanco reported that she is working on securing an 8-10 piece Mariachi group to play at the event between 11:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Zumba will perform from 3:30 – 4 p.m. She is pricing a DJ who will play CDs during the unscheduled times. Normalicia asked Ginny to find out the stage height, and also requested that there be no carpet on the stage.
  - b. Food – Ginny reported that Jeff Burgos from Planet Bounce (Sandstone Café) will vend Mexican Hot Dogs and Menudo at the event. He is also giving us a great discount on an inflatable bounce house. Ginny is still waiting to hear back from Manuel's regarding their vending status. Ginny has been given the OK from the City event coordinators to contact Food City for possible sponsorship of the Mexican breads.
  - c. Logistical Needs – The committee suggested headers and additional tables and chairs be provided.

The Committee agreed to wear their Tardeada Guaveras shirts and their Tardeada name tags. A volunteer sign up sheet was passed around for the committee to sign up to work the arts and crafts booth and the coffee booth.
